THE I-26 CONNECTOR WILL SERIOUSLY IMPACT THE ASHEVILLE BUSINESS COMMUNITY

The entire 7-mile I-26 Connector project consists of three segments that NCDOT plans to build consecutively. If everything goes as planned, each section will take 4 or 5 years to build. If construction progresses as scheduled (and when does that ever happen with NCDOT!?) Asheville can expect at least 15 years of highway construction in its future!!! The unnecessary complexity and size of the Alternative 4B design promises to be a construction process nightmare.

ONCE FINISHED, THE WESTERN FRONT DOOR TO DOWNTOWN ASHEVILLE WILL BE CHANGED FOREVER

Instead of a view of thriving neighborhoods, greenways, and the irreplaceable asset of the French Broad River, residents and visitors alike will be "welcomed" to our western front door with three new elevated highways towering ten stories above the river, concrete retaining walls from Patton Avenue to Broadway, and up to 16 lanes of highway jungle on both sides of the river at the western edge of downtown! As other cities are tearing down elevated highway structures because they essentially wall off their surroundings, it makes NO SENSE for Asheville to accept these plans that tower over the surrounding Asheville cityscape.

WHAT IS DWAC?

The "**Don't Wreck Asheville Coalition**" (DWAC) is a grassroots organization made up of Asheville residents and businesses that are united in our determination to prevent the construction of this ruinous highway project that can't be downsized or minimized as City leaders are hoping.
